Galena Area Airports and Shuttles

There are cities with regional airports that are closer than O'Hare however O'Hare is the largest. It is easy to get to the resort from any of the airports below. You can find transportation to Eagle Ridge from any airport. If you have attendees that are coming in around the same time or even on the same flights, it might be easiest to coordinate a limo/town car transfer or even rent a car.
