Time:

The study will occur at 1-5 timepoints between 3 and 12 months of age.

*Additional visits may be needed

Compensation:

Participants will be compensated for their time.

Eligibility:

- Infants between 1 and 12 months of age
- Normal hearing OR diagnosed with permanent bilateral hearing loss
- English or Spanish as primary language spoken at home
